Dear Sir

I wish you the best of all the worlds on assuming the high office of CMD, BSNL and promise you of all the support in bringing BSNL back to its number one position in Telecom field in India.

As is very well aware to your kind self that the stay has been granted on the conduct of JTO LICE on All India basis by the Honourable CAT at Earnakulam. It is to be noted that the petitioners involved here are mostly those officials who have been earlier given undue and undeserved advantage by BSNL management by declaring them as qualified in a screening test which was thus quashed by the Hon. High Court of Punjab and Haryana and the same decision was ratified by the Hon. Supreme Court of India by disposing of the SLP filed by these interests.

You would accept that the root cause of the present situation is due to the diversion of the quota to promote these candidates who were otherwise not eligible for promotions. It is being seen that the Kerala Circle Administration is biased towards the petitioners and are working against the interest on BSNL. We have serious doubts that the Kerala Circle officials will not submit proper reply to the Hon. CAT at Earnakulam and thus would indirectly help the petitioners. This would eventually lead for another rat race in the court rooms. This is in the long run will damage the image and functioning of BSNL only.

I sincerely request you to instruct the Kerala Circle Administration to properly defend the case in the Hon. CAT against the stay given on JTO LICE and pave the way for an early conduct of JTO LICE.

I urge you to do the needful urgently to save the future of thousands of young recruits from becoming redundant and in turn save BSNL. I wish management take this issue with utmost seriousness as its outcome may fill the young recruits with more enthuse or otherwise it may deepen the crisis further.
